



NetLibrary Instructions

The Nazarene Theological Seminary Library offers free e-books online through the [NetLibrary](#) database. You must set up a NetLibrary account, before you can read e-books directly on your computer screen.

Get Started:

1. Go to [NetLibrary](#) (from outside the Library, you will need your library card and PIN).
2. You must set up a separate, [free NetLibrary log-in](#) to read or download books. (This is separate from your library card and PIN.)
3. Search the [NTS Online Catalog](#) for books and enjoy!

Finding Books:

Browse by Subject

- Use any **keyword** to get both physical books and electronic books on any subject
- Type in **netlibrary** (all one word) as a keyword to see all 396 electronic books
- Type in "netlibrary" with "and" any topic to get only electronic books on 1 topic (for example="netlibrary and church" retrieves 168 electronic books)

Search

- **Search by Author or Title** using the dropdowns next to the search box.
- **Limit your Search** to only e-books in the [Advanced Search](#) page.
- **Use the Right Side of the Screen** to revise your search, view related topics, and see your previous searches.

Reading e-books:

Reading e-books is easy! Locate the book you want and click **View this e-book** beneath the item. Turn pages using the **Previous** and **Next** buttons on the upper right. You can also move between chapters using the table of contents on the left hand side.
