The Certificate in Pastoral Counseling program is limited to students currently enrolled in the M.Div. program.* This program provides focused training for pastors desiring to enhance their counseling skills and increase their knowledge of the relational, emotional and psychological needs of the people with whom they minister. The certificate course of study requires a total of 16 credits: 7 credits for specific courses within the M.Div. requirements and 9 credits for specific pastoral counseling courses. Students in the Pastoral Counseling Certificate program must take SPF/COU675 – Counseling and Spirituality as their required SPF elective, and will take COU721 and COU731 – Supervised Ministry in place of PTH721 and PTH731 – Supervised Ministry Experience.

*All M.Div. students must take PTH500 – Personal & Spiritual Development of the Minister and PTH550 – Pastoral Care and Counseling.
