The Certificate in Pastoral Counseling program is limited to students currently enrolled in the M.Div. program.* This program provides focused training for pastors desiring to enhance their counseling skills and increase their knowledge of the relational, emotional and psychological needs of the people with whom they minister. The certificate course of study requires a total of 15 credit hours: 6 credit hours for specific courses within the M.Div. requirements and 9 credit hours for specific pastoral counseling courses. Students in the Pastoral Counseling Certificate program must take SPF/COU675 - Counseling and Spirituality as one of their required Ministries of Formation courses, and will take COU621 and COU721 - Pastoral Counseling Supervised Ministry in place of PTH621 and PTH721 - Supervised Ministry.

*All M.Div. students must take PTH505 - Core Relationships for Christian Ministry and PTH550 - Pastoral Care and Counseling.
