STUDENT EXPENSES INFORMATION (referred to on page 2 of the Scholarship and Financial Aid Handbook)

The Financial Aid Office uses student cost data from governmental and private sources with standardized cost-of-living information for Kansas City to calculate its cost of attendance. Updated tuition and fee figures are established by the NTS Board of Trustees. Costs of books are based on estimates obtained through booklists provided by the NTS Bookstore. All this information is used to determine the total cost of attendance for each academic period, provided to students for budgeting consideration.
