45 total hours required at NTS for a NTS M.Div.

NTS would like to have at least one course from each domain taught through NTS.

Thus we want at least one course in Bible from among the four courses in Hermeneutics, OT Exegesis, NT Exegesis, and Biblical Theology.

We would like a six hour package in Theology, Church History, and Philosophy. We would like either Doctrine of Holiness and Christian Ethics or the Integrative Theology 1 and 2 or History of Christian Doctrine 1 and 2.

\* Courses marked with an asterisk (\*) are eligible for Advanced Placement (which would reduce the total hours required for graduation). AP testing should be taken at the beginning of the program Tests may not be taken “backward” in order to receive credit for a course.

† Integrative Theology 1 is prerequisite for Integrative Theology 2 and History of Christian Doctrine 1 is prerequisite for History of Christian Doctrine 2. (In other words, a student may not mix and match Integrative Theology and History of Christian Doctrine courses.)

All students enrolled in the M.Div. program must participate in the Middler Assessment to fulfill NTS degree requirements. Format is still to be determined for students in the collaboration agreement.

Hours based upon semester delivery system.

A total of 45 hours may be transferred into NTS.
