365M | 365 DAYS IN MISSION, a DIPLOMA IN CROSS-CULTURAL MINISTRY, is a collaborative effort between Nazarene Theological Seminary, participating universities, mission agencies, and individuals desiring a “hands on” cross-cultural learning experience. Students earn 24 hours of graduate school credit, and spend 9 months studying and ministering in a cross-cultural learning environment.

BRITISH ISLES

In either the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland, students will work with the local church, seeking innovative ways to engage the community.

BULGARIA

Under the mentorship of regional missionaries and local church leaders, students will explore the impact of culture on evangelism, church planting, and youth ministries.

KENYA

Hosted on the campus of Africa Nazarene University in Nairobi, this site is for students with a specific call to higher education in a cross-cultural setting.

NEW YORK CITY

In the heart of Manhattan, students will engage in the multicultural, multigenerational, and multiclass urban ministry of the local church that seeks spiritual, social and cultural transformation.

NEW ZEALAND

Students will be involved in the daily ministry of the church as they learn how the variety of cultures in New Zealand (Maori, Samoan, European, and Korean) contribute to the life of the church and its mission.

365M | 365 DAYS IN MISSION is designed to increase students' global awareness and engagement. The unique program allows students to spend 9 months in a cross-cultural environment under the supervision of trained theological, formational, and cultural mentors. Prior to and immediately following the cross-cultural immersion, students will complete coursework on the NTS Kansas City Campus. At the conclusion of the program, students will have completed 24 credit hours, earning a Diploma in Cross-Cultural Ministry.
