VC (Video Conferencing Classroom): Enrollment in a video conferencing class shall require that a student be located a minimum of one hundred miles from Kansas City campus and secure the permission of the course professor to enroll in the course. The student must:

1. Purchase and install the Polycom PVX software to allow them to video conference. The software is a onetime purchase and is approximately \$125.
2. Be connected to a High-speed Internet connection with a minimum of 386k **upload & download** speed
3. Possess a Windows computer with a tested webcam
4. Use a headset with attached microphone
5. Complete a test connection with NTS from the location they wish to take the class (i.e. home network, church network, etc.)
