### **Job Description:**

**Christ Church Anglican is seeking a Director for Student Life Ministry at our 2 congregations.**

### **Our Church**

Christ Church, a multi-congregational Anglican church located in the greater Kansas City area, exists to be a people fully alive in God's Kingdom. We value reaching unchurched people through graceful hospitality, ministering in the power of the Holy Spirit, innovation, and mobilizing people to serve and lead.

### **Position Purpose**

We believe Jesus' promise of abundant life is offered to everyone – including children (Acts 2:38). Therefore, we are seeking a family life team member to help us grow the faith of our students and reach new students to help them know Jesus and follow Him joyfully into adulthood.

In this role, you will envision new ways to reach out to our wider community, tell the stories of transformation happening in our families, and mobilize new team members to execute student ministry. We are looking for a vibrant Christian who serves out of the overflow of their relationship with Jesus Christ, is energized by working collaboratively in an entrepreneurial environment, and is appreciative of the depth and vitality of the Anglican tradition.

### **Essential Functions and Responsibilities:**

#### **1. Visionary Leadership**

- Prayerfully discern where God is leading
- Provide leadership for current student life ministry structures and programming and envision new and strategic ways to make disciples of students and families at Christ Church through the lens of our overall church vision and in partnership with the family life team.
- Articulate vision for student ministry to the church in a way that inspires and engages the congregation

- Develop and execute a communication strategy with regular news and updates for student ministry so that students and parents can be informed easily engage in ministry events
- Periodically evaluate effectiveness of ministry programs through both subjective and objective feedback

## **2. Develop and execute weekly ministry to the students of Christ Church OP & Mission**

- Weeknight middle and high school ministry
- Weekly Sunday morning preteen/middle school Sunday School
- Assess and select curricula, in partnership with the Family Life Director, that will support and accomplish ministry goals.
- Identify, pursue, and train new adult volunteers
- Equip, support, and develop existing adult volunteers
- Provide a leadership presence on Sunday morning and weeknight student ministry activities.

## **3. Plan and execute special events**

- Organize and lead Soul in the City
- Oversee/facilitate our confirmation process
- Organize retreats & trips for students to grow in their faith
- Plan and execute fun events to engage students in community life
- Envision new events and mission opportunities for students/families

## **4. Perform other ministerial duties to students and families**

- Support, encourage and resource students and families as needed for mental, emotional, and spiritual health
- Pray for parents, students, families, and leaders
- Partner with and equip parents with discipleship resources and training

## **5. Staff duties**

- Steward budget and resources
- Integrate students into other Christ Church initiatives
- Report to Family Life Team Leader and attend Family Life Team meetings
- Attend Staff Prayer and Staff Meetings
- Maintain calendar of events

## **6. Personal Development**

- Practice personal spiritual development and disciplines
- Participate fully as an active member of the Christ Church community
- Ongoing ministry development and training
- Network with like-minded ministry leaders
