

# Cabin Leader

## **Description:**

Cabin Leaders are the primary servant leaders to campers in the overnight program at Camp West. Each Cabin Leader is assigned to a cabin for a session along with a second Cabin Leader (either an adult volunteer or Summer Staffer). Together they provide direction for the program, serve the church or other adult volunteers attending the session, and serve as spiritual mentors to campers. They spend the majority of the day with campers engaging in relational ministry. Experience volunteering or working with children or youth in a ministry setting is preferred but not required.
